Plastic packaging



– recycled into new plastic products

Plastic bottles and plastic cans
Plastic pots
Plastic lids
Plastic bags and plastic film

Remember to rinse packaging
– with cold water *



Toys
Large plastic items
Rainwear and rubber boots
(due to PVC content)
Bubble pack. Curling ribbon
Plastic cans from paint, chemicals
and strong detergents
(they often carry a danger symbol)

Plastic packaging must be deposited in the green containers labelled with plastic.

Small metal items



– are recycled into new metal products

Drinks cans
Food cans
Metal kitchenware
Small metal items
Aluminium foil trays

Remember to rinse packaging – with cold water *



Plastic bags
Large metal items
Spray cans and pressure bottles
Electrical items such as toasters,
telephones etc

Small metal items must be deposited in the green containers labelled with metal. Large metal items should be put with bulk waste.

Paper



– used paper is recycled into new paper

Newspapers and magazines
Advertising
Envelopes - including window envelopes
Paperbacks and telephone directories
Writing and drawing paper
(paper clips may be left on without problem)



Cardboard
Plastic
Milk cartons
Hardback books
Plastic bags
Advertising wrapped in film

Paper can be deposited in one of the black public containers or in the green containers labelled paper if there is one in your building.

Cardboard and paperboard



– recycled into new packaging

Cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard and
paperboard
Cardboard packaging from toys, toothpaste etc.
Toilet paper rolls
Egg cartons

Remember to flatten the cardboard or squash
it, so it doesn't take up too much space.



Soiled packaging
Pizza trays
Milk and juice cartons
Books – hardbacks and
paperbacks
Plastic. Flamingo
Paper

Cardboard must be delivered to bulk waste or in the green container labelled cardboard, if there is one in your building.

Glass



– recycled into new glass

Glass food containers
Wine and spirits bottles
Juice bottles
Preserves bottles
Glass vessels for the items mentioned

Remember to rinse packaging – with cold water *



Ceramics
Porcelain
Crystal glass
Window glass
Ordinary light bulbs
Low energy light bulbs.
Strip lighting
Empty medicine bottles

Glass must be deposited in one of the public black glass bins.
